In 2023, the National Information Technology Development Agency (NITDA) approved a partnership with Advocacy for Policy and Innovation (API) to develop a bill aimed at protecting Nigerians from online harms.

OUR APPROACH

Since commencement of the partnership, API has prioritised a people-led approach, engaging a range of relevant stakeholders in a three-tier model involving a Steering team to drive the development of a framework for the bill; a Secretariat to support the Steering team and manage the bill project ; and working groups comprising subject experts whose interests need to be represented in the proposed bill.
