API is working with relevant authorities and stakeholders towards seamless adoption of einvoicing in Nigeria

KEY ISSUES

Insights from the operations of relevant authorities such Nigeria's Federal Inland Revenue Service (FIRS) and National Information Technology Development Agency (NITDA), underscored the need for digitising service delivery, with particular focus on boosting efficiency through adequate frameworks and governance structures around e-invoicing

OUR ROLE

API is working with key stakeholders and relevant authorities (FIRS and NITDA) to develop a national structure and governance framework for the adoption of e-invoicing in the country. API led the development of a draft Regulatory Guideline for E-invoicing and a National Framework for Einvoicing in Nigeria, to be issued by NITDA. We also work closely with regulators and stakeholders to ensure that robust frameworks and governance structures around einvoicing are agreed upon and adopted. This includes serving as the Secretariat for the newly established Invoice Access Point Providers Association (IAPPA).

OUTCOME



Regulatory Guidelines for E-Invoicing in Nigeria

API developed the <u>Regulatory Guidelines for E-</u> <u>Invoicing</u> in partnership with NITDA.

API currently serves as Secretariat for the Invoice Access Point Providers Association (IAPPA), which is aimed at enabling seamless adoption of e-invoicing.
