Following the ban imposed on social networking site, Twitter, by the Nigerian Government from 2021 to 2022, API intelligence tracker and in-house research highlighted that the absence of clear, concise, and accepted framework for digital rights gives room for confusion and incoherence, which may result in arbitrary actions that malign citizens.

API hosted a summit themed "The Challenge for Content Moderation and the Opportunity to Improve Online Safety in Nigeria" as part of a series of knowledge events to provide ample context on comparative approaches for developing a people-oriented and fit-for-purpose framework to protect Nigerians Online.
